- Sweden: INFORMATION on what applies in Sweden for all competing dogs according to Swedish national regulations.
 - Sweden: Information about results achieved from a country outside your own, see attachment to MOM.
 - As a Swedish dog/team you cannot mix results from another country with the ones from Sweden.
 - Competitors from outside Sweden cannot get a result in their record book according to their home countries rules, at a competition in Sweden.
 - Please see the attachment from the Commission of Test and Competitions of the Swedish Kennel Club

These points were discussed, Sweden do not accept the point of classification according home country, as the Swedish rules states that foreigners follow Swedish rules for classification.

We did not agree on this point as it is up to the home country to classified, as we have been told by old committee members, there is an agreement about this, Håkon will see if he can find the MOM where this is written. Sweden will have this MOM before an agreement is made.

The FCI agility rules states that national regulations are up to each NCO to decide on, they say nothing about home country regulations for dogs competing abroad. Actually, the FCI has no authority over national competition regulations, so all the remarks in the FCI agility regulations about national and even unofficial competitions are really

not necessary.

Agreement made by NKU are supposed to be an agreement within the Nordic. Håkon will go back to SKK and check again.

- Finland: Proposal about level change, measurement, joint Nordic teams for EO and JEO, Nordic Junior championship
 - 1: Finland: proposal about level change, measuring, joint Nordic teams (EO, JEO), Nordic Junior Camp
 - 1) results to change the level:
 - the dog must be able to change the level to the higher class according its own national rules
 - competitor must provide to the competition organizer the rules according it is changing to the upper level in its origin country
 - -> If the origin country don't accept results from other countries then the dog cannot change the level in other country

Already discussed at the point from Sweden

2) Measuring:

- the national measuring must be respected. If a dog comes for other Nordic country for competing it competes in the class it has been measured in its own country
- -> if only FCI sizes, then according the FCI sizes
- -> if national sizes that are not in the origin country, there is a possibility to define the national size in the country where the competition is held
- -> it is the choice of the origin country if they accept the result in other classes than their own-

These points were discussed, point 4 was withdraw. Will be further disused at the AWC.

3) Nordic teams for EO and JEO

 Proposal that all Nordic countries would give a 1st chance to form a joint Nordic team if there is not full teams from their own country. Finland sends / is sending part of full teams and also so has participants without a full team.

Finland presented the idea and we will go back to our Kennel Clubs for feedback. Will be a point at the next meeting at AWC.

4) Nordic Junior camp and Nordic Championships

 is there an interest for joint agility camp for junior handlers and/or the Nordic Junior Agility Championships
