- "The sidestep must be taken in a straight line to left or right as shown below, A and B is correct, C and D is not correct." Agreed that C is minus 3 and D is minus 10. This must be added to the judging guidelines.

Paul will update the Guidelines and publish in the group.

#### 5. Judging guidelines

Sit-jump-stand discussed. We agreed that a jump is allowed when moving from sit to stand.

No changes are needed in the judging guidelines except the deductions for sidestep mentioned above.

We agreed to publish Regulations and Guidelines when we have approved the Guidelines. A date for publishing must be agreed in our Facebook group.

#### 6. Coming championships

Finland will arrange the 2022 championship. Invitations has been sent.

Norway will arrange the 2023 championship. The date hasn't been decided yet, but its important that it is announced soon.

Sweden will arrange the 2024 championship.

It was agreed that Paul will update the Specifications based on input from the 2021 championship.

# 7. Judges training weekend

The training weekend has been agreed to take place 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> February 2023.

Number of participants will be 16 judges: 4 from Denmark, 3 from Finland, 3 from Norway and 6 from Sweden.
